CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF ORDINANCES are made in three ways :—(1) Weekly Offerings in envelopes placed on the collection plate each Sabbath ; (2) Quarterly Subscriptions ; (3) Contributions placed on the collection plate. The first method has been adopted by the greater part of the congregation, and the Managers greatly prefer that it should be adopted by all. The sittings are all free, no pew rents being charged to any one.

ENVELOPES are given at the beginning of each quarter, and on the allocation of sittings ; and any one not now receiving envelopes, and desiring to contribute in this way, is requested to give his or her name to any of the Managers, who will attend to the matter. All those who occupy sittings are expected to contribute according to their means to the current expenses of the congregation.
