

ITHACA, N. Y., Sept. 5—The brain of Mrs. Helen Hamilton Gardner, bequeathed to the Cornell Brain Association by the terms of her will, has arrived at the College of Medicine here from the Walter Reed Hospital in Washington, D. C., where it was removed following her death a few weeks ago.

Dr. James W. Papez, secretary of the association, has begun a study of the organ.

Mrs. Gardner, an author, was the only woman member of the Civil Service Commission. Her brain is said to be normal, well proportioned and excellently preserved. It weighs the same as that of Dr. Burt G. Wilder, which was added to the Cornell collection upon his death last January. The weight of each is 1,150 grams.
