

Street Oil.

We purchased during the season three tanks of road oil. We could have avoided distributing so much on account of the rainy season; but one would scarcely expect to have had so much rain during the months of July and August, as we had last year. Oil seems to be a very necessary material to lay dust and I think we will have to encourage its use even more than has been done in the past.

In addition to repairs on the streets with tar macadam, considerable repairs have been made with gravel and tar macadam between the street railway tracks, which is chargeable to street railway tracks, which is chargeable to street railway tracks, which is chargeable to street railway account for which the city is paid \$1,000 a month. During the year for repairs and removal of snow, etc., this amounted to \$14,544.78.
