## PROTEST AGAINST FEATURE OF HARVEST EXCURSIONS

A strong protest was registered yesterday by the local board of trade against harvest excursions which, by giving cheap transportation from East to West without any corresponding rates in the opposite direction, yearly rob the east of Canada of a large number of its citizens for the benefit of the West. The protest took the form of a resolution which had been drawn up by J. M. Robinson, president of the board of trade, and which was endorsed by the council which met yesterday. Besides the decision to communicate directly with the railway commission to ask that such discriminating rates of fare be disallowed, the resolution contained a clause which will result in a request being sent from St
