London, April 24.—If the Duke of
York and his fiancée had nothing to do
but thank people for the wedding pre-
sents which pile up daily, they would be
very busy. Secretaries help some of

practical use for the presents, and that
is going to be a task in itself. For in-
stance, no fewer than fourteen walk-
ing sticks for his Royal Highness are
listed among the many duplicates.
For the most part the presents are
what people call practical. And, natu-
rally, they are somewhat above the
ordinary. No salt shakers or cut glass
nut bowls or leather bridge sets have
yet been counted among the articles
received by the Duke or Lady Eliza-
beth Bowes-Lyon. But there are ciga-

would expect, many numbers of clocks,
and a set of silver candlesticks.
But these candlesticks are different.

and bridegroom. One article is a
Dresden China clock and mantel orna-
ments which date from the time of
King Augustus the Strong, a contem-
porary of Louis XIV of France.

Various delegations have gone up to
Buckingham Palace and formally con-
gratulated the Duke on becoming be-
trothed, and cities and organizations
all over the land have presented con-
gratulations through the mail. The
Duke has had to write letters of
thanks, of which the following is a
sample:

"Dear Lord Provost: I wish to
thank you, and through you the magis-
trates and councillors of the City of
Dundee, for the congratulations which
you have addressed to me on my ap-
proaching marriage. I value very
highly the loyal expression of good
wishes and goodwill which you have
offered to me, and I value it especial-
ly as coming from those whom I may
call the neighbors and fellow citizens
of my future wife.

"The Lady Elizabeth Bowes-Lyon
joins with me in thanking you and
those whom you represent for this
congratulatory address which has been
a very real pleasure to us both to
receive."

ite color, like that of Mrs. Harding, is
blue.

chiffon more dress of old ivory color
and of a simple medieval style, em-
brodered with silver and pearls with

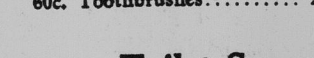

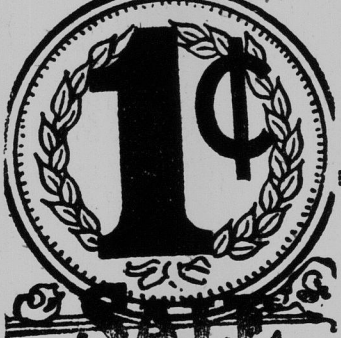
