FAIRVILLE MAN LOSES WIFE IN LAKE ACCIDENT

Mrs. Gerald Griffin Drowned
as Automobile Breaks
Through Ice

FAMILY PARTY
HAVING OUTING

Car Struck Thin Ice—All
Are Saved Except
Woman.

Word of the tragic death by drowning of the wife of Gerald Griffin, son of Mr. and Mrs. Patrick Griffin, formerly of Fairville but now of Bangor, was received recently by Mr. and Mrs. William Haggarty of Fairville, Gerald Griffin's uncle and aunt. The fatal accident occurred at Lincoln, Me. on Sunday. Mr. and Mrs. Gerald Griffin were motoring from their home in East Millinocket, Me., and with them were their 18 months old baby, Miss Adelaide Marden of Old Town and Vennie Theriault of East Millinocket who was driving the car.

Drives on Ice

The party arrived in Lincoln, Me., at about 3:45 on Sunday afternoon and after driving about the village decided to take a spin on Lake Mattanawook. They were returning and at about 5 o'clock were close to the shore when they drove into the thin second crop of ice on the cutting field in the lake and the car broke through and sank immediately in 12 feet of water.

Child Saved

Mr. Griffin saved his child but was unable to save his wife. He was hampered by the fact that the side curtains of the car were down. Her body was recovered half an hour after the accident.

dent by volunteers who had dived repeatedly into the icy water before they were able to locate it. Efforts at resuscitation were unsuccessful. Other members of the party were thoroughly chilled but were cared for by the people of Lincoln.

The ice cutting field was not marked or guarded in any way and Thierault was unacquainted with the conditions. No blame is attached to the driver. Mrs. Griffin was 21 years of age, and her untimely death has come as a great shock to her husband's relatives here.

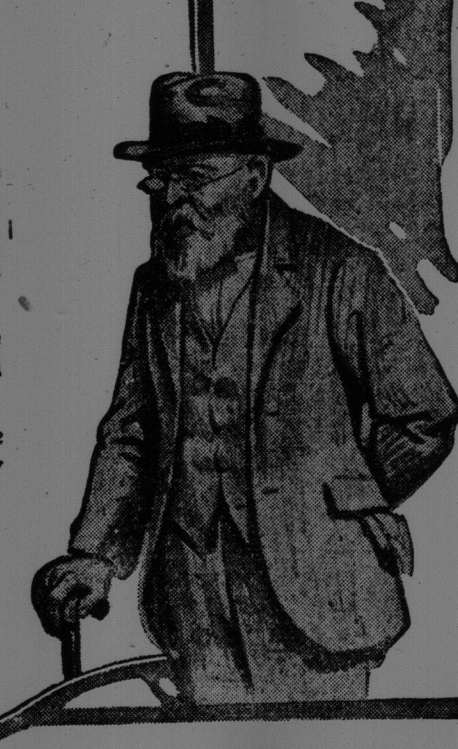
