day of thanksgiving.

15th. That the first day of January be observed as a day of fasting and praying for the spread of the Gospel.

16th. That the same Committee for Missionary exertions be continued, viz. Elders EDWARD MANNING and DAVID HARRIS, and Brethren HOMES CHIPMAN and WILLIAM CHIP-MAN; and that Elder THEODORE S. HARDING be added to the above number.

17th. That Brother WILLIAM COGSWELL be our Treasurer. 18th. That Elder GEORGE DINOCK superintend the printing of the Minutes-500 copies to be printed.

19th. That our Churches be requested to observe the evening of the first Monday in every month, as a time of united and special prayer for the advancement of the cause of God both in Heathen and Christian Lands.

20th. That a vote of thanks be inserted in the Minutes to the Mite Societies, and others who have aided in the Missionary cause; particularly to the Mite Societies in Chester, Lunenburg, Windsor, Margaret's Bay, Antigonish and Annapolis:—Also, that it be recommended to all the Churches in this connection to imitate such laudable examples; and to each Minister to use his endeavours to advance this good work.

21st. From statements made by those who were employed as Missionaries during the past year, it appeared that the benefits rerulting from their labours had increasingly been owned and blessed of God, and afforded ground of much encouragement.

22d. That this Association certify that the License given Brother RICHARD PRESTON (a man of colour) by Elder JOHN BURTON in behalf of the Baptist Church at Halifax to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ, is a proper License, and that Elder WILLIAM ELDER, Moderator, sign the same.

23d. Voted, that thanks be given to the Church and Congregation at Clements, for their kindness and hospitality during the present Session.

24th. That 25s. per week be allowed to Missionaries the present year, and all expenses paid:—the Missionaries find their own horse, and account for all monies received in aid of the Mission cause. 25th. The past
