In England and in the United States, the dependants of the dead would be entitled to compensation from their employers and so would the incapacitated survivors of the disa-ter, and it is persumed that such is the case here. These people are not the proper objects of charity; there is a debt due them wich should be paid now in their hour of need, and they should be subjected to no humiliation. It may be, as was intimated, before, that their cases have been investigated and their wants attended to, but if not, a movement to that end should be put on foot at once and it should not take the form of charity.
