VARIETY.

DISEASE OF THE TEETH.—The disease which usually attacks the mouth and occasions that terrible pain—often of such intensity as to prevent a person from happy ridings—is scientifically called caries. It is a decomposition of the bone, which, beginning at the outside, rapidly penetrates to the pulp of the tooth, and exposes the nervous tissue to the action of air and cold. It is a disease of the bone, or where it is removed by the pressure of tooth upon the other, or some other cause. As the teeth are supplied with blood vessels, it has been a question whether caries was not produced by an irritation of the nerves, or by the action of the tooth, as sometimes produced in the bone, but in a more tenable position; so that the low degree of sensibility in the tooth, causes it to cause inflammation, and that disease must ordinarily arise from causes external to the tooth, such as unhealthy secretions of the skin, or the action of the body, or some other cause, or a neglect of cleanliness. All acids which are found to act upon the teeth more or less, and the seeds generated in the salivæ in an unhealthy state of the system are peculiarly poisonous. Food adhering between the teeth is liable to putrefaction and is easily taken up by the carious tooth, and is easily imbibed by the pulp; but greater power will wear off the enamel, and thus hasten the decay of the teeth. Care should be taken to secure the proper articles of dentistry which do not mechanically or chemically irritate the tooth. And this will be rendered easier by timely care, that the tooth does not overlap or press upon another.

By properly cleaning the teeth, and by watching over the moment it makes its appearance, and arises with other symptoms, may be removed by a good old age. To this end parents must begin in season, and submit their children, even during the existence of the first set of teeth, to the inspection of a competent dentist, and insist upon the removal of every tooth, as soon as it is found to be carious. The remedy for the neglect of this is to visit a dentist, and to have him thoroughly examine the teeth.
