

PROCEEDINGS

OF

Annual Meeting of the Society.

THE TWENTY-FIFTH ANNUAL MEETING of the MISSIONARY SOCIETY of the W. M. CHURCH IN CANADA, was held in the Wesleyan Church, BROCKVILLE, on Tuesday Evening, the 11th day of June, 1850, Rev. MATTHEW RICHEY, D. D., in the Chair. The Meeting was opened with singing and prayer : an abstract of the Report having been read by the Rev. ENOCH WOOD, Superintendent of Missions, the following Resolutions were adopted :—

- I. Moved by Rev. WILLIAM POLLARD, seconded by Rev. C. BYRNE,—

That a Report of the operations of the Society for the past year, an abstract of which has now been read, be printed and circulated.

- II. Moved by Rev. J. CARROLL, seconded by Rev. Dr. BANGS,—

That this Meeting rejoices in the openings of usefulness which invite the labourers of this Society in the destitute settlements of the Province, and amongst the Indians of the West ; and as success can alone be secured by the Great Head of the Church, the friends of this holy enterprise are invited to continued and earnest prayer for the enlargement and triumphs of Messiah's Kingdom.

- III. Moved by Rev. WM. CASE, seconded by Rev. H. WILKINSON,—

That this Meeting sympathizes with the Parent Society in England, on account of the difficulties which it has encountered during the past year ; but rejoices in the noble and munificent income by which the work of God on their extensive Missions throughout the world has been sustained. Engaged in the diffusion of Christian knowledge amongst the destitute, this Meeting expresses its high gratification in the large increase which has been reported from the Branch Societies of this Institution, and pledges itself to continued offerings to this heavenly work.
