(she d. 1858.) 2ndly in 1859, Miss Cyminta Foss., of New Hampshire, U. S. (she d. in 1865) Has been President of the Agricultural Society of Co. Albert. First returned to Parliament at last g. e. WALSH, Aquila, *J. P.* [*Norfolk, N. R.*] C.

S. of F. L. Walsh, Esq., Registrar of the County of Norfolk, and formerly a mem. of the U. C. Legislature. The family is of Irish descent, having formerly owned and occupied Castle Hoyle, in Kilkenny; a branch of the family subsequently resided near Dunganannon, in Tyrone, and emigrated to America about 1740; they took part in the war between France and England, and subsequently on the loyal side between the latter and the revolted Colonies; removed to New Brunswick and afterwards to Upper Canada.
