An Act to abolish the property qualification now required of Members of the Legislative Assemblv.

HEREAS by Imperial Act, commonly known as the Union Preamble. Act, and other Acts now in force in this Province, provisions Imp. Act, 8 & have been made for requiring, on the part of Members of the Legislative Assembly, a certain qualification in respect to property: And whereas 5 it is expedient that such provisions should be repealed, and by the Imperial Act passed in the seventeenth and eighteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, chapter one hundred and eighteen, power has been given to the Parliament of Canada to vary or repeal the said provisions of the Union Act; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:
