

the receipt of a Collector of Her Majesty's Customs for the rate or duty payable in respect of such Vessel for the then current year have been produced and shewn to him; and it shall be the duty of every Inspector to report to some one of the Collectors of Her Majesty's Customs, any case of omission to pay such rate or duty or of omission to apply for such inspection as aforesaid, for more than six months from the date of the then last inspection, or refusal to submit to inspection at any time which may at any time or in any way come to his knowledge.

XIV. All penalties incurred under the said Act or this Act, may be recovered in the name of Her Majesty, by Her Majesty's Attorney General in any Court having jurisdiction to the amount thereof, and all penalties recovered under the said Act or this Act, shall be paid to the Receiver General, and shall be by him placed to the credit and form part of "The Steamboat Inspection Fund."

XV. The word, "Steam Vessel," shall mean any Vessel propelled in whole or in part by Steam, and the word "Owner" shall include the Lessee or Charterer of any such vessel.
