

Receipt for redemption money to be a good title, when registered.

3. Every such receipt after the enregistration thereof in the Registry Office of the County of Huntingdon, shall, as between the person obtaining the same and the said Indians, be equivalent to a title under letters patent of the Government, and shall discharge every such lot or part of a lot designated in such receipt from all future rents or other charges which have heretofore been payable on the same in favor of the said Indians for whose benefit such lands were reserved by the Government. **5**

Account to be kept, &c.

4. The said Commissioner of Crown Lands, as Superintendent of Indian Affairs, shall keep an account of all sums deposited in his hands and shall pay over the interest thereon annually or semi-annually to the said Indians in any way which he may deem most beneficial to them. **10**

Public Act.

5. This Act shall be a Public Act.
