1) How do you think the construction will ultimately affect the quality of campus life? 2) Why is Coca-Cola the official soft drink of summer?



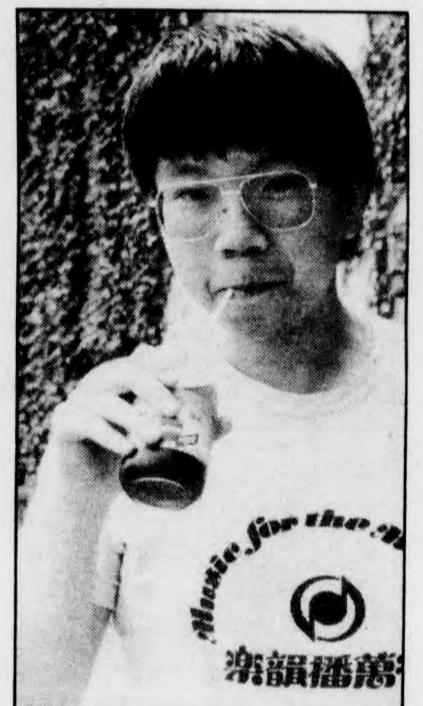
Sergio Gizzo, Poli Sci/Mass Comm
