May it please your Ex^{ty}

We take this oppertunity to Inform your Ex^{ty} y^t yesterday arrivd here Mon^r Lasanganie Gov^r of trois riviere. accompanyd with some Officers message is to your Ex^{ty} & Intends to Sett out from hence in 2 or 3 days by what we hear is y^e Subject of his Erant is att our Building at Oswege Mr. John Tuppets from N. England who has been to Canada to redeem his Captive Children Inform us y^t 400 french & 200 Indians have been ready to March directly to Oswege to Destroy y^e building kill & take our people & their goods, but has been happily by the advice

the advice Mons^r Lasanganie who has Offerd his Service to Undergo y^e fetaque of this Journey to Mediate this Affair with your Ex^{ty} Mean time an Officer is Sent to Oswege with orders to desire our people their to desist from building till they have y^e result of this message their forces are to be kept ready at an hours warning y^e Indians of Cacknawage have firmly promised y^e Gov^r of Canada not to have any Communication with this place. J^r Tuppets is going to New York who Can give your Ex^{ty} a particular Acc^t how Affairs are at Canada

Inclosed is a letter from Capt. Banker wherein is no better Intelligence y^t we have from Montreal.

The Com^r agreed with Mr. Jacob Visger to Carry Mon^r Lasanganie Gov^r of trois riviere now in town with people in his Company in his Sloop to N. York for Seven pounds ten Shillings for y^e trip down & for four pound ten Shillings up hither again & to lye 2 or 3 days at N. York
