| Camp Borden, Ont. | 19-10-42 | | F/O W.A. Nugent (C5384), was buried at St. Aidans Church, Toronto, with full Air Force honours. The ceremony began at 1430 hours. Seven officers from this unit attended. | |
| | 20-10-42 | | At 0800 hours ceiling and visibility unlimited with light overcast building up in the afternoon. Light Southerly wind, 10 hours solo, 0800 hours to 1800 hours. Night flying 1900 hours to 0400 hours. Total flying time 610.55 hours. The entire civilian staff at R-1 Edenvale walked out because they were not provided with closed transportation to their quarters off the station. There being no accommodation on the station. There was no mess help available for approximately 24 hours. | |
| | 21-10-42 | | At 0800 hours ceiling unlimited and visibility at 1000 feet, 3 miles ground fog, clearing to 5 miles in the afternoon. Wind-South 10-15 miles per hour. 5½ hours dual 4½ hours solo, washed in at 0800 hours and washed out at 1800 hours. No night flying, rain and fog. Total flying time 366.45 hours. | |
| | 22-10-42 | | At 0800 hours ceiling unlimited and visibility 8 miles in hazy overcast, building up in the morning. Changing in the afternoon to heavy rain. Ceiling zero visibility zero. Washed in at 0800 hours and washed out at 1400 hours ½ hour dual and 5½ hours solo. No night flying. Total flying time 280.25 hours. Yale Ha64-3375 piloted by P/O W.R. Welsh, (J11974), pupil Aus. 425016 IAC Huston, A.M., nosed up on landing at R2 Alliston at 1430 hours. Both occupants were uninjured. Aircraft overshot field, struck log and nosed up. Categorized "C¼". | |
