NOTICE OF CONSOLIDATION

To the above named Settler:

This Notice issued pursuant to The Soldier Settlement Act, 1919, and amendments thereto, is to notify you that pursuant to the said legislation, your total indebtedness to The Soldier Settlement Board incurred prior to the first day of April, 1922, inclusive of any advances on account of taxes and insurance made between the said date and the date hereof, together with interest on the whole of such sum, has been consolidated as of the first day of November, 1922.

Your Indebtedness as aforesaid consolidated amounts to .....

Two thousand two hundred and forty ..... 46 /100 Dollars made up as follows:

Principal \$	2,106.45
Interest \$	134.01
Total \$	<u>2,240.46</u>

This amount (provided payments are made as due) shall be free from interest up to the first day of November, 1924.

The Said Total consolidated indebtedness is payable by you in twenty-five instalments as follows:

AN INSTALMENT OF \$ 89.62 (being one twenty-fifth of the said consolidated indebtedness) payable on the first day of November in each of three years, namely: 1922, 1923, 1924,

AND THE BALANCE, with interest thereon, at the rate of five per cent per annum in twenty-two equal consecutive annual instalments of \$ 149.78 payable on the first day of November in each of the years 1925 to 1946 (both inclusive).

If default be made in the payment of any instalment of one twenty-fifth herein referred to, the amount of such instalment or the unpaid portion thereof shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum from the due date until paid.

The Amount now due and payable by you is made up of-

1st. Instalment of one twenty-fifth of consolidated indebtedness \$	89.62
2nd. Special Advances (including interest) -----	\$ .....
Total amount now due and payable -----	\$ <u>89.62</u>

Advances for Land permanent improvements or stock and equipment made to you between the first day of April, 1922, and the date hereof, but not included in the indebtedness or due payments above mentioned, will be repayable by you in twenty-four equal consecutive annual instalments with interest at the rate of five per cent per annum on the amortization plan and will correspond as to dates of repayment with the terms of repayment for the said consolidated indebtedness.
