MONTCALM, 21st Feb'y, 1920.

"About 2.15 this afternoon struck open lead which kept fairly well open till about within fifteen miles of Entry Island after an nour butting broke into clear water and anchored Pleasant Bay 5.15 p.m. expect get into shore ice tomorrow and discharge cargo, stop. Your message received and instructions noted.

MONTCALM, 22nd Feb'y, 1920.

"Got in shore ice 6.40 this a.m. about one and half miles from Grindstone wharf now landing cargo on ice expect finish tonight.

MASTER".

MONTCALM, 23rd Feb'y, 1920.

"Finished Magdalens last night left 6.00 a.m. now working east through heavy ice doing fairly well so far.
