debts, we have experienced an improvement in our oradit. We are able to borrow at lower rates of interest than before, with the result that our annual debt oharge is aiminishing proportionately nore rapidiy than the principal sum of our debt. IncludIng the saving of $82,650,000$ as a result of the repeyment of this autum, the total annual interest oharge on the debt as at the end of the present year, w111 be between $\bar{\beta} 122,000,000$ and \$123,000,000, as compared with nearly $323,000,000$ in 1922 - a saving of a full $\$ 15,000,000$ a gear in interost oharges.

## Reductions in Taxat 10 n

But the repayment of debt, which has had far-reaching effects In improving the national oredit, has not been the sole accome plishment of recent years. Together therowith has gone the reduction of taxstion. Up to 1925 , it is true, the paramount necessity of the Dominion was the balanding of its budget, and While there were rectuctions of texation in many direetions, the total was not groatly affected. After the budget had once been balanced, however, the situation was ohanged, and in each of the last three budgets of $1926,192 \%$ and 1928 there have been large reductions of taxation, offiaially estimated to have cost the Treasury of Oanada $\$ 25,000,000, \$ 27,000,000$ and $\$ 19,000,000 \mathrm{per}$ annum respeotively - or a grand total reduction
