



Sir-

m I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant, relative to rental payable to Peter Sault for land on the New Credit Indian Reserve, and in reply to say that the sum of \$21.76 returned in his favour on the 2nd instant was made from rental paid under lease of the land of Allen Sault, upon the Agent's requisition which was as follows- "A cheque for \$21.76 should be returned in favour of Peter Sault, who still has a claim of \$31.62, and one year's interest, against the locatee Allen Sault."
