Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 13th January last submitting a tender for supplies required by the Department to be delivered at various points in the Keewatin District, and to Department's letter of the 10th February last accepting your tender amounting in the aggregate to \$5,794.30, I beg to state that in view of your telegram of the 11th instant the Department has approved of the itinerary submitted by Mr. Inspector Semmens to carry out the work he has been entrusted, and it will expect that the supplies will be delivered at the various points on the dates suggested by Mr Semmens and at the prices quoted in your tender.

I herewith enclose a supplementary order for school supplies for Norway House, Cross Lake, Nelson House and Split Lake Bands, which I would request you to deliver with the other supplies.

I may say that the supplies for Norway House, Band may be required at an earlier date than that suggested by Mr. Semmens, namely, 11th August, but you will be advised in due time if a change of date is made.

The supplies should be inspected at Winnipeg before being shipped and you will please call upon Mr. Hugh Richardson, of the Department's warehouse, Winnipeg, to make the inspection when they are ready.
