
Gentlemen:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th Instant, respecting the timber on the Wahnapitae Indian Reserve, which you hold under License No. 130, and in reply to inform you that if you have not cut any timber thereon since you acquired it, an affidavit to this effect is required, which should state your reasons for not having worked the Limit.

With regard to your having transferred your interest in the Limit to the Cane Mfg. Company without first paying the ground rent and renewal fees and complying with the Timber Regulations of the Department, I have to state that the question as to recognition of the Transfer cannot be considered until all the requirements shall have been complied with.

Timber cut by the Company under authority of transfer from you will be liable to seizure, and condemnation, as provided by the Indian Act.
