
Ottawa, 11th July, 1912.

Sir,

The late Agent for the Parry Sound Agency has forwarded to the Department a letter received by him from Forest Ranger Peter Stock, reporting that the Chief of the Gibson Band has again issued permits to fish to a number of tourists, although he has been informed by the Department that he should not issue licenses to fish or hunt on the Gibson reserve.

Be good enough to ascertain from the Chief whether the statement made by the Forest Ranger is correct and if so what amount of money has been collected for these permits, and what disposition has been made thereof. You should also warn the Chief that the instructions given him regarding the issue of these permits must be observed.
