Sir-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th Instant, with enclosures, relative to the issue of Location Ticket to Maria King for the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 6, Range 2, Caradoc, which land was formerly held by the late William King, under Location Ticket No 1374. In connection with the foregoing, I have to request you to furnish me with a full report in this matter, stating when William King died, whether or not he died intestate, what heirs, if any, survived him, as, unless in case of failure of heirs and the reversion of land to the Band, no Resolution is needed, as the land is always dealt with under the provisions of the Indian Act.
