Sir:-

In regard to the matter of occupation by Thulin Bros. of a piece of land that you claim to be your location and of which you spoke to Mr. Bury the Timber Inspector when he visited the Sliammon Reserve last summer, I have to state that if you will forward a letter signed by the Chief of the Band stating that your father was the bona-fide owner of this piece of land and had cleared and cultivated it prior to occupancy by Thulin Bros., the question of refunding you the rental which has been collected, and authorising you to take possession of the building vacated by Thulin Bros. will be given consideration.
