Ewenty Five (225) acros, more or less, subject to survey, the same to be constituted an addition to Reserve No. 4 of the appliance of the land and constituted a Reserve for the Application and established and constituted a Reserve for the use and benefit of the applicant Douglas Tribe, Skookumchuck Band, that portion of the land applied for under the said subitem "C" which was covered by Timber Limits Nos. 3989P and 5980P, expired, containing in the aggregate an area of Fifty (50) acros, more or less, subject to survey.
