 troubles charges and incumbrances whatever
 had done or suffered by any of us the said
 chiefs or by any one whatever of the said
 nations our and their heirs Executors or
 administrators and by these presents do make
 this our act and Deed irrevocable under any
 pretence whatever and have put his said
 Majesty in full possession and seized by al
 lowing Houses to be built upon the premises.

In Witness whereof we the said Chiefs for ourselves
 and the said Nations have unto these presents made the
 marks of our different Tribes and affixed our seals at
 Detroit District of Kepec in the Province of Quebec
 this nineteenth day of May in the Thirtieth year of the
 Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third King of
 Great Britain France and Ireland Defender of the
 Faith &c. and in the year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred and ninety.
