

**GODERICH, ONT.**—The Council gives notice of its intention to construct cement sidewalks on Trafalgar and Cobourg streets and Cambria road.

**WETASKIWIN, ALTA.**—L. R. Rix will soon begin building a two-story block.—It is expected that the Bank of Commerce will soon begin work on their new building.


