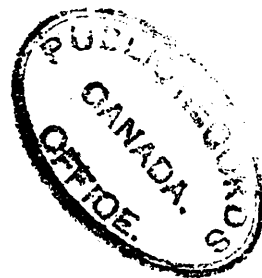

11^o VICTORIÆ.



Began and Holden at Halifax on Saturday, the Twenty-second day of January, in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-eight, in the Eleventh Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lady VICTORIA, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, and of the United Church of England and Ireland, on Earth the Supreme Head.

His Excellency Lieutenant-General SIR JOHN HARVEY, Lieutenant-Governor of this Her Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, &c. &c. &c., having, by his Proclamation, dated 23d June, 1847, dissolved the last General Assembly, and having called a new one; and having afterwards, by his Proclamation, dated the 1st December, 1847, appointed Saturday, the 22d day of January then next following (this day) at Halifax, for the Meeting of the General Assembly for the *Despatch of Business*.
