**WESTPORT.**  
Saturday, June 13.—The hurried changing of the church bells, the shrill screams of the locomotive and the excited yells of fire! at two o'clock Friday morning of our busy burg to the fact that the fire had had at last a break in the history of our village and that the latest addition to the business of the town, the building of the Westport Stone Foundry, was in flames. Soon willing hands were busily engaged in fighting the hungry monster but in vain, and in a short space of time the structure was a mass of smoking ruins, while the fire had already commenced havoc with the tinsmith of John McGuire which soon fell a prey to the flames. By strenuous efforts and untiring vigilance the residence of Mr. McGuire was saved and the progress of the flames checked. The origin of the fire is unknown, but circumstances point strongly to incendiarism. No fire had been used in the part of the building where the fire commenced, for two days previous thus giving no possible chance of fire from that quarter and the fact that some articles of Mr. McGuire's had during the night of the 11th been stolen from the office clearly indicate that some one had at least been through the premises. The loss of the Stone Co., borders closely on \$6000 with an insurance of \$1500 but beyond this all is a total loss as not even a hammer was saved. **Newspapers and their Friends.**  
A newspaper, if it has any brains, conscience and muscle back of it, must continually decide between doing duty and having its pocket full. In any position but that of an editor the public is able to separate the individual from the collective citizen. But if the editor does not please them, it's his pocket they aim at. Thus it is that newspapers learn who their friends are. The man who reads a newspaper and admires it all the year around, yet gives his business support to some other concern, whose principles he detests, is not a friend of the former paper.  
Admiration alone will not run a newspaper. Sooner or later such admirers will find that the object of their affections has become wedded to other ways that they do not admire. In other words, a newspaper is compelled, in order to live, to seek the friendship of those who are not so platonic in their love, but unite that practical esteem with sentiment that binds mutual admiration in other professions. There are too many men who expect an editor to slave in defence of their pet notions and hobbies, advocate their views against the strongest opposition and coolly withhold the business support by which alone a small newspaper can live.  
Talk about a newspaper having a public duty to perform, and an editor having to labor for his principles, is cheap when other stand back and, while extending a lukewarm neutrality with one hand, are filling their pockets with the other hand as a result of the editor's labor for his principles, which they admire but do not support.

**Village Council.**  
The regular monthly meeting of the municipal council was held on Wednesday last 10th inst. The levee, clerk, and councillors Berney and Greene, present.  
Minutes of regular meeting read and adopted.  
Leave was granted to introduce a by-law to appoint a pound keeper for the village of Athens, which passed through its several readings and was finally passed. The provisions of the by-law being that H. C. Phillips was appointed pound keeper for the year 1891 to act under the provisions of by-law No. 286, passed by the municipal council of the township of Reynolds and Escot, which said by-law is to remain in force in the village of Athens until repealed. Note.—A copy of this by-law hung up in the clerk's office for the inspection of the public.  
Mr. Berney moved, seconded by Mr. Greene, that this council is of the opinion that the practice of ball playing on the streets of this village is a public nuisance and that the clerk be instructed to print 25 copies of a notice warning all persons that to graze or allow horses, cattle, &c., to run at large. Racing or furious driving, rowdy conduct, swearing, and any other conduct in any public meeting are strictly prohibited within the corporate limits and that all officers of the law are instructed to see that the law in respect thereto is enforced.  
The council then adjourned until the next regular meeting unless sooner called by the levee.

Ashwood Hall, June 11th.—To all parties connected with the Board of Trade, with the possible exception perhaps of the few opposed to the action system, the meeting of the 11th of the meeting to the salemen who were out in force, pleasing to the "small fry" gentlemen, (the card by which some of the buyers who favor the open bid for the goods have come to be known), pleasing to the officers, and also the newspaper men who rejoice to record business done in a business way.  
After business was opened by the President, Mr. Webster again brought up the question of sales made off the board. M. K. Everitt took objections to Mr. Webster's insinuations respecting such sales. Mr. Webster in reply said if necessary he could name the men who had thus transgressed, he could also name the buyers and the confidential price paid by them.  
Mr. Lang of Ogdensburg moved, Mr. H. Bissell seconded, that no cheese under special offer or sold be registered on the board without notice of offer on sale being also registered. The motion was carried strong.  
The offerings totaled 6,218 lbs. boxes, 8,193 colored, balance white. Bidding was sharp. The small fry boys had fairly good orders to fill. Nearly all was sold at from 83c. to 85c. inclg away.
