Composite or Steel Built, fitted to contend with ice, for the Postal Service, North, South and West of St. John's, and to be employed on any other Public Service that the Governor-in-Council may, from time to time, direct.

These steamers must be about 1,000 tons, gross measurement, 200 feet long, 31 feet beam, draft of water not to exceed 16 feet when loaded; to have accommodation for 60 Cabin and 90 Steerage Passengers, and to be fitted with all modern improvements. The Service for the North will be Nineteen Fortnightly trips, commencing about the 1st May, 1919, and on the same date in subsequent years; the Service for the South and West will be Twenty-six Fortnightly trips in each year, commencing about 1st May, 1919.

Both steamers to Class X 100 A1 at Lloyd's (England), for Ten Years and to have a speed of at least 12 knots.

The Contract to be for a term of 10 years to be computed from the term of commencement of the Service.

Tender to specify the rate per round trip at which each service will be performed.
