WORK OR BEAR DEMANDED. Hundreds of Laborers Parade the streets demanding Employment or Food.

A spectacle, happily never before witnessed in Toronto, started the citizens yesterday morning. Several hundred workmen met in St. Andrew's square in response to this notice:

All laborers out of work are requested to meet at St. Andrew's square at 11.30 sharp, tomorrow, Wednesday morning.

Over 800 workmen formed in line headed by the two of their number, Messrs. Britton and Lamb. Preceded by a drum and a black flag bearing the inscription "Work or Bread," the unemployed marched along King-street to the City Hall.
