#### New Regulations.

Copies of the new regulations and course of study, for Public and High Schools, have been distributed by the Education Department. An examination of these reveals a number of important changes.

Grammar is no longer on the course of study for the third classes of the Public Schools and the course in this subject for fourth classes has been considerably simplified.

The course in geography for all classes in Public Schools has been radically changed, physical, commercial and economic geography is to receive much greater attention than it has received in the past. An effort is to be made to adopt the course of study in each school to the needs and the special conditions of the locality. In schools with only one teacher the trustees may substitute for art and nature study, one or more of the following subjects: Domestic science, manual training, elementary agriculture. Physical culture is obligatory in all classes of the public schools, and a manual will shortly be issued by the Education Department for the guidance of the teacher in taking up the subject.

A two years' course of study is outlined for the first year's course. On completing the first year's course a pupil may take an examination which will entitle him to a junior graduation diploma; both these examinations will be conducted by the Education Department and either diploma will admit a pupil to a High School.

The character and scope of the entrance examination is unchanged, but in future it will be known as the Junior High School Entrance Examination. This examination loses much of its importance from the fact that there are three other ways of securing admission to a High School, namely, (1) by means of a junior graduation diploma, (2) by means of a senior graduation diploma, and (3) by passing the senior High School entrance examination. The latter examination admits the candidate to the middle school of High School.

With a view of securing more favorable weather conditions, the foregoing examinations and also the examination for admission to the Faculties of Education and the Normal School are to be completed by the 30th of June.

#### NOTE AND COMMENT.

There are now 2,523 branches of chartered banks in Canada. Twenty new branches were opened in September.

Windsor is the marrying town. In the last three months 900 nuptial knots were tied there. Ninety-five per cent. of the couples were non-residents, most of them from the United States.

A new road machine which has been recently tested by the people of Portland, Oregon, is said to solve the problem of economic road making. The roller is run along in its wake and completes the task, thus doing away with the usual shovelling gang. Thus one man operates the machine and does the work of a dozen with hand tools. The finished highway is said to be as good as city pavements.
