Prices remain stationary except in a few cases. An improvement was noticed in Deer Trail No. 2 which is selling x-d to-day; 2,500 shares changed hands at 11 cents, an advance of ½ a point over Saturday's prices. The demand has greatly improved and higher prices may be looked for.

The most important strike as yet was made at the close of last week, when the big No. 1 vein was met in the crosscut at a depth of 200 feet and a distance of 110 feet from the shaft. The ore body is strong and is likely pretty wide. The crosscut was in 3 feet of ore on the 8th inst, and the quartz pans well. This strike gives Decca stoping ground for many thousands of tons of ore.
