T is all very well talking, and arguing, and holding our own against them, but why can we not do something?" This was the very practical question that Frederic Ozanam put 'o himself and his seven friends in a little room in Paris, in 1833. Ozanam was a brilliant young French; Catholic who had been for sometime crossing swords with

atheists and scoffers at religion, the aftermath of the French Revolution, and he had grown weary of a well-nigh fruitless task. There is little to be gained in controversy with scoffers; deeds will often move them when words have failed.
