THE DISTRESS IN ENGLAND. THE MEASURES FOR RELIEF SPREADING—INCREASING THE POLICE FORCE—LABOR DISTURBANCES AT LEICESTER.

LONDON, Feb. 11.—Three hundred unemployed workmen called upon the Lord Mayor to-day to urge upon him the necessity of doing something to relieve the distress among the unemployed of London.

FARM AND GARDEN

WINTER AMONG THE VEGETABLES, FLOWERS AND CATTLE. Where milk can be sold at three cents per quart it will pay as well as butter at twenty-eight cents per pound.

GRAPE CUTTINGS FOR NEXT SPRING'S PLANTING may be made now. Cut into convenient lengths for packing, and during leisure hours make up into cuttings.

PLANTS AND SIMILAR PLANTS are frequently attacked by the scale, which adheres so closely to the leaves and stems that it cannot be readily removed.

ROOTS TAKEN FROM THE BLACKBERRY plants the pest should be cut into lengths and packed into boxes with sand. These boxes should be stored where frost cannot reach them.
