
Table 3.1: Size and Segmentation of the U.S. Environmental Market - 1991 (+/- \$120 billion U.S.)

With regard to the wastewater management market more particularly, Miller & Associates estimate it at \$31.4 billion in 1991, distributed as follows:

Capital expenditures

Industry and public utilities \$ 5.5 Municipalities \$ 11.5

Operations and maintenance expenditures

Industry \$ 5.1 Municipalities \$ 9.3

The EPA is forecasting that \$110.6 billion will be spent on wastewater treatment over the next 20 years.

The lawmakers' emphasis on reduction at source (prevention), as opposed to traditional "end-of-the-line" treatment, will oblige industry and municipalities to innovate technologically and find more flexible and creative financing methods.
