Previous Concessions and Contracts

The Administrations of the Postal Union of the Americas and Spain undertake to adjust to the provisions herein all previous concessions or contracts which are subject to renewal and which they have concluded with private postal transportation companies; this also applies to contracts which are concluded hereafter.
