DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENTS

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointments:

Mr. George E.B. Blackstock (52), born in Toronto, Ontario, as Consul General in Munich.

Mr. Blackstock [B.S.A. (Economics), University of Toronto, 1955; post-graduate studies, Carleton University, 1957] joined the Department of Trade and Commerce in 1957. He has served abroad in Buenos Aires, New Orleans, Berne, London and Stockholm. From 1974 to 1975, he was Director, Agriculture, Fisheries and Food Products; from 1975 to 1976, Acting Director General, Agriculture, Fisheries and Food Products; from 1977 to 1979, Deputy Consul General (Commercial), New York; from 1979 to 1983, Consul General, Minneapolis; and from 1983 to 1985, he has been Director, Management Review. Mr. Blackstock replaces Mr. W.J. Collett whose appointment was announced earlier.
