(b) five-twelfths of the total of the amounts of Items 76, 268 and 296 of the said Estimates;

(c) one-quarter of the total of the amounts of Items 94, 216, 359 and 497 of the said Estimates;

(d) one-twelfth of the total of the amounts of Items 139, 161, 182, 185, 186, 197, 198, 199, 201, 203, 207, 211, 212, 270 and 394 of the said Estimates;

(e) one-sixth of the total of the amounts of Items set forth in the Supplementary Estimates for the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1959, as laid before the House of Commons at the present session of Parliament, except Items 545, 546, 547 and 627;

(f) one-sixth of the total of the amounts of Items 635 and 654 set forth in the said Supplementary Estimates,

be granted to Her Majesty on account of the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1959.

Resolution to be reported.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in, and the Committee of Supply obtained leave to sit again at the next sitting of the House.

The House resolved itself again into Committee of Ways and Means.
