

as he may require that such approval has been given and that the provincial Company has ceased to do business or will cease to do business forthwith upon a certificate of registry being issued to the Company."

"10. The Canadian and British Insurance Companies Act, 1932, shall apply to the Company."

The said amendments were concurred in, and—

With leave of the Senate,

The said Bill, as amended, was then read the third time.

The question was put whether this Bill shall pass.

It was resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That the Clerk do go down to the House of Commons and acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, to which they desire their concurrence.
