NOTE.

In this sketch of the "Little Dutch Church" we get from the records a glimpse of those early times, and the environment in which its promoters lived.

Much might be said, in general terms, of the German settlers and the trials which they had to brave; but as far as the little Church is concerned—its building and services—we have tried to record everything of interest.

This landmark stands at the corner of Gerrish and Brunswick streets; and visitors wishing to inspect the same may do so by applying at St. George's rectory, where the keys of the Church are kept.
