



MAP SHOWING THE DIFFERENT LINES OF BOUNDARY CLAIMED BY THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA ABOUT LYNN CANAL.

The numerals (1), (2), and (3) above Lynn Canal indicate the Provisional Boundary lines arranged between the United States and Great Britain in October, 1899. They are about 20 miles from tide-water, and bar Canada's territorial rights along the upper shores of Lynn Canal, and injuriously affect her privileges of passage and coasting trade within what are claimed as the upper, or British, territorial waters, and to and from the Pacific Ocean.
