BARTON FINALLY READY SAILS HIS NEW AIR3HIP** London, July 23.—Dr. Barton's air-ship, 127 feet long and carrying five persons, was tested at the Alexandra palace grounds yesterday. It has been under construction since 1901 and was ready in July, 1904, but the gas gen-erator exploded during the process of filling, severely injuring Dr. Barton. There is a 50-horsepower motor at each end, four propellers and two aero-planes at the bows. The total weight is 61-4 tons. Barton's son, a boy of fourteen, was among the crew.
