QUEBEC SCHEME

RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1st.—That no grant be ordinarily more than \$200 per annum to one Mission, or to one Clergyman.

2nd.—That in future, where there is no special condition, grants be made for *three* years from the first of the month either next preceeding or next following the date; and that they cease, in every case, at the expiration of that period, unless renewed, at the least, *six* months before their termination.

3rd.—Toward the representatives, pay of June and salary as made by Church Soci-

5th.—Sheweth that the said parish or manor is not a Bill of intermeddling, and that the same is making up the
