Chicago, April 9.—Chicago's latest venture in the suppression of vice is the morals court.

The express purpose of the court is to prevent as well as punish crimes and misdemeanors over which it has jurisdiction. Those brought before it will be given an opportunity to change their way of living and many agents have volunteered to assist. Practically every civic betterment and philanthropic institution in the city pledged its support to the movement. Positions will be found for women who desire to reform their lives and strong efforts will be made to punish commercialized vice.
