slight tremor of the earth was felt on shore.

The effect of the explosion seemed to cover a space of four or five acres, and the water was lifted up bodily in numberless columns of spray to vary-ing heights, from 100 to 150 feet.

No less than 6,300 cubic vards of rock were to be removed under the dead pressure of 143,000 cubic yards of water, and 52,000 lbs. of dynamite were used.

Apparently the work was thoroughly done, and the obstruction entirely removed or pulverized.
