

DOMINION IMPORT TRADE

A summary of the trade of Canada for the 12 months ending October 31, issued by the External Trade Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, shows a total import trade to the value of \$859,626,267 for 1921 as compared wth \$1,239,639,454 for 1920, and \$902,359,438 for 1919. Buty collected in the 1921 period amounted to \$127,481,946, as against \$210,236,382 in 1920, and \$16,317,422 in 1919. Total exports during the period in 1921 amounted to \$8941,566,435 as compared with \$1,263,784,553 in 1920, and \$1,252,051,959 in 1919.

During the 1921 period Canada imported goods from the United Kingdom to the value of \$129,035,546, and exported goods to the United Kingdom to the value of \$296,778,084.
