VILLAGES.

VILLAGE OF ALTONVILLE,

Partly in the Townships of Ashfield and West Wawanosh, on the gravel road leading from Goderich to Lucknow, seventeen miles, contains one store, one hotel, one shoe shop, one blacksmith shop, and is surrounded by a first-class agricultural district, and presents a good opening for any branches of trade not already represented. Mr. John Loughead keeps the only hotel in the place in very good style.

VILLAGE OF BLUEVALE,

A station on the Wellington, Grey and Bruce Railway, on the town line between Turnberry and Morris, thirty-three miles from Goderich, contains four hotels, two general stores, one grocery store, three blacksmith shops, two shop'shops, two tailor shops, one grist mill, two saw mills, one planjng mill, two shingle mills, one cooper shop, one tannery, one waggon shop, one cheese factory. The Bluevale Hotel, kept by Mrs. Stowe, is a very good house.

VILLAGE OF BRUCEFIELD,

A station on the London, Huron and Bruce Railway, nineteen miles from Goderich, contains two hotels, three general stores, two blacksmith shops, one shoe shop, two tailor shops, one waggon shop, one carpenter shop and two doctors. The British Exchange Hotel is well kept by Mr. Elliott, the landlord, who spares no pains to make his guests comfortable.

VILLAGE OF CREDITON,

In the Township of Stephen, — miles from Goderich, contains three hotels, three stores, two shoe shops, three blacksmith shops, two waggon shops, three cabinet makers, one tin shop, one tailor, one cooper, one saddler, one saw mill, one grist mill, one flax mill, one carding mill, one doctor, Sparrs' Hotel furnishes first-class accommodation for commercial men and the general public.

VILLAGE OF DUNGANNON,

Partly in the Townships of Ashfield and West Wawanosh on the gravel road leading from Goderich to Lucknow, thirteen miles from Goderich, contains three stores, two hotels, two shoe shops, two blacksmith shops, one tailor, one waggon shop, one harness shop, one milliner shop, one cheese factory, one doctor.
